



## **2010 Endeavour Rally South**

**3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> September 2010**

Motorsport Endeavour once again brings you the experience of road rallying with Endeavour Rally South.

Starting in motorsport valley in the Midlands, this non-competitive event incorporates visits to world renowned motorsport venues before an overnight halt in Winchester at the brand new (opened March 2010) Holiday Inn, and an event dinner in a social environment with guest speaker(s). Day 2 continues in the same vein, visiting more famous motorsport venues before the finish for tea on the terraces at the Houses of Parliament in London! There, we will pass out the awards for the completion of the event.

After the signing-on formalities are completed, you will be instructed in the broad requirements for the event before taking to the road. You will be under minimum pressure with a time schedule that ensures you enjoy the experience.

Crews will be introduced to the essentials of rallying:-

- You don't need a Competition licence
- You can use your own road legal car with no additional preparation necessary
- We will introduce you to the simple essential skills you will need to enjoy the event
- Rally fee includes evening dinner (maximum of 2 tickets per entry – further tickets can be purchased separately), refreshments, rally plates, road book, and prize-giving and overnight accommodation at the brand new Winchester Holiday Inn (one twin or double room per entry – further rooms booked at own cost)
- Mechanical backup and assistance provided by The AA
- At least one person per car should have a recognised disability.
